She relocated to Port Elizabeth and then joined the staff at the PE Technikon (now the Nelson Mandela University) as senior lecturer, where she fulfilled various roles and retired several years ago.

Brenda was an active member of SORSA. She held various positions on the Port Elizabeth branch in the 1980s and early 1990s. She served on national council for many years and was president of SORSA from March 1996 to March 1998.
